She graduated from Abilene High School in 1940, of which Erna was on the drill team, and also the honor roll.

Erna began college at Hardin Simmons University in Abilene. Due to financial needs and the start of America's involvement in world war 11, she left school, then went to work for the US government in a secretarial role. Her work led her to move to Chicago, where she lived in an apartment with 3 other ladies. She remembers her time in Chicago as an exciting time where she lived life to the fullest as a single woman. Following the war, she moved back to Texas to be close to her mother.

On June 17, 1949, Erna married Raymond Axe and settled in Garland, Texas. Erna and Raymond chose to be married on June 17th because that was Raymond's birthday and thus, easy for Raymond to remember.

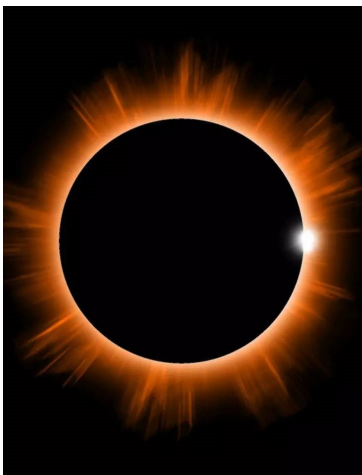
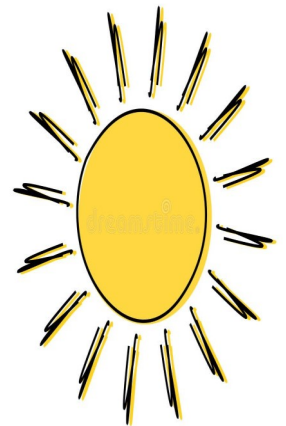
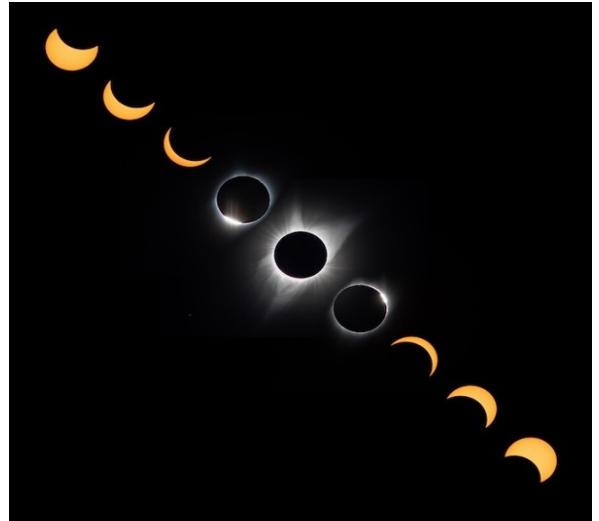
