## Chocolate Caramel Cake by Maxine

Chocolate Caramel Cake

 1 pkg German Chocolate cake mix  
 1 can condensed milk  
 1 cup caramel sauce  
 8 oz. whipped topping (Cool Whip)  
 Prepare German chocolate cake as directed on box for a 13 X 9-inch cake pan. Remove from oven. While still hot, using the handle of a wooden spoon and poke holes in the top of the cake at approximately 1-inch intervals. Pour can of condensed milk over top slowly and evenly so it will soak into cake. Repeat with caramel sauce. Chill. Frost with whipped topping. Decorate with chocolate casts or coarsely chopped candy bars.

Buttermilk Pie  
 3 3/4 Sugar  
 1/2 cup flour  
 1 tsp. salt  
 2 sticks butter, melted  
 6 eggs  
 2 c. buttermilk  
 1 t. vanilla  
 2 (p inch) deep dish crust preferably homemade.

Preheat oven to 350. Mix sugar, flour and salt together by hand mix in melted butter, Mix well by hand. add buttermilk and vanilla, pour half of mixture in the baking pie crust, bake at 350 for 15 minutes, then lower the heat to 300 and bake for 1 hour.


