
Monthly Tidbits

Did You Know?

The term mayday is often used as a distress signal for sinking ships and crashing planes. But what does May Day, the celebration on the first day of the month, have to do with the distress call? Actually, the distress term is a mispronunciation of the French phrase m'aider, which simply means "Come help me!"

Birthstone —Emerald

Emeralds have long been a favorite of royalty; Cleopatra favored them and had them mined extensively in Egypt during her reign. Shah Jahan, builder of the Taj Mahal, wore an emerald talisman inscribed with holy text for luck and protection. Emeralds can grow very large, and large ones have been found in recent years at Kagem, the world's largest emerald mine, in Zambia. A 5,655-carat emerald was unearthed there on October 2, 2018. The Kagem emeralds are believed to have formed more than 450 million years ago, which may be one of the reasons for their large size.



The lily of the valley is a very fragrant plant and is highly prized for making perfume. Lily of the valley water was once considered so precious that it was kept in gold or silver containers. In folklore, it is believed that the scent of this flower in the spring air is the signal for nightingales to begin their seasonal singing and choose a mate. In the language of flowers, the lily of the valley means sweetness, humility, and

perfect purity. It also signifies the return of


