Arbor House Assisted Living and Memory Care is the only Alzheimer's Certified Memory Care in Waco. While 85% of our residents do have some form of cognitive impairment, we have many residents that have no signs of a cognitive disease. There are many articles with recommendations to improve cognitive health on the internet, and some activities that should be avoided.

For someone with a cognitive impairment late in life, it is important to stay active. Staying busy both physically and mentally keeps the brain active. In Assisted Living, we have several engagements throughout the day, and in Arbor Gardens, we do a different engagement every 30 minutes throughout the day. We do this to prevent our residents from becoming bored and deciding to do something less stimulating. The engagements that we do every day provide each person with opportunities to socialize with each other, be productive and contribute, experience success, play, build and retain skills, have a sense of control, meet religious and spiritual needs, and experience growth and learning. We meet these needs by purposely choosing activities that keep our resident's bodies, minds, hearts, dreams, friends, purpose, and feelings in motion. These are all things that we take for granted because our brains make these decisions on their own. For someone experiencing a cognitive impairment, their brains may choose activities that do not aid in a happy and healthy lifestyle.

Each of our team members at Arbor House are trained on the effects of different cognitive impairments and the benefits from the programs we provide. There are always going to be events that we cannot predict ahead of time, but our team uses their knowledge and resources to accommodate each resident's unique personal needs. There are some activities that may cause more stress to someone with a cognitive impairment. We do our best to not involve the use of televisions, complicated electronics such as cell phones, and music/sounds that they may not enjoy.
