#### **Salem Witches**

A person that stood mute refused to plead guilty or not guilty. The punishment for it was "Peine forte et dure" which is a method of torture known as a pressed death. Any defendant who refused to plead was subjected to having heavier and heavier stones placed upon his or her chest until a plea was entered, or death resulted.

# A brief bit of history which may have started the fear over Friday the 13th

Twelve is considered to be in many cultures as <u>complete</u>. Mathematically it can be divided into half, thirds, and quarters. A few examples of this are the 12 tribes of Israel, 12 days of Christmas, 12 hours a day, 12 months in a year, 12 zodiac signs & the 12 Gods of Olympus & Norse mythology. The 13th disciple at the Last Supper, Judas, is who betrayed Jesus Christ. This led to Christ's crucifixion that was held on a Friday. Some biblical scholars also believe it was a Friday when Eve convinced Adam to eat the forbidden fruit, & it was Friday the 13th when Abel committed the first murder, killing his brother Cain. Fridays were dubbed the "hangman's day" since many public executions also occurred on them in the Middle Ages. The criminals would have to walk 13 steps up the gallows before meeting their fate. It's not often to find hospitals that skip the 13th floor, 80% of American hotels skip it as well. Winston Churchill refused to sit on the 13th row of a plane or theatre. Franklin D. Roosevelt never dined with 12 others & avoided travel on the 13th. What's interesting enough is that "Fewer accidents, reports of fire & theft occur when the 13th of the month falls on a Friday vs on other Fridays, because people are preventatively more careful or just stay home."
